“to apply a tax”

assessable

assessor

ASSESSMENT vs ACCESS

Don't confuse either with
ascension, ascend, ascended
ad + *scandere* (to climb)

ACCESS

ad (to) + *cedere* (to go, move)

“ability to enter, retrieve”

“an entrance”

Cedere
also has the sense of
withdraw
seen in words such as
cede, recede, concede

accessed
(in) accessible
(in) accessibly
(in) accessibility

access **to** location
access **for** someone



K sound is for **Key**
